Augustinian Delegates Re-elect Prior General.

The 186th General Chapter of the Augustinian Order opened on September 1st, 2019 in Rome. The General Chapter is at the centre of our Augustinian way of life and is the highest decision making body of the Order.

The General Chapter takes up many issues during the three weeks in session. Among them is the election of the Prior General and his Curia, the establishment or suppression of circumscriptions, and many other topics concerning Augustinian religious life.

Fr. Alejandro Moral Anton, OSA was re-elected as Prior General of the Order for a second six years, and goes into effect immediately.

After tallying the votes, Chapter President Fr. Joe Farrell invited the friars to the chapel of St. Monica's College, where Fr. Alejandro formally was installed into his second term. Following, our Prior General received the congratulatory embrace of every friar present at the Chapter.

Fr. Alejandro comes from Madrid in Spain, and it is his responsibility to coordinate the work of the Order's almost 3,000 members in over 50 countries, on every continent. To assist him in his work the General has four Assistant Generals who take responsibility for different areas around the world. As part of his Visitation to the Limerick community in 2017 Fr Alejandro also joined us for the conference on Martin Luther and con-celebrated at the 11.15 Mass that Sunday.

We wish him every blessing on his re-election as Prior General and pray that he will continue to strengthen the ministry of the Augustinians in Ireland.
