

Important Arrangements for Leaving the Church

To help keep us all safe it is important that we leave the church building in an orderly and organised manner, maintaining social distancing.

Those who are leaving, begin to leave from the back rows. When you are ready to leave please do not begin to exit the church unless you can respect social distancing recommendations of **2m at all times.**

The Government recommends that masks be worn in indoor settings

Important Arrangements for Coming to Communion

To protect all of us, and in line with government and church leaders' advice, the arrangements for going to communion in this church, for the foreseeable future, are as follows:

1. Communion will only be distributed from the two communion stations you can see on the sanctuary.
2. All those coming to communion must come up by the central aisle, single file and return to their seats by the two side aisles – even though this may mean having to walk a longer distance than is normal.
3. While queuing for communion please be careful to observe the recommended social distance of 2m, or six feet.
4. Having received communion, please return to the same seat you were occupying previously – do not change seat.
5. Communion will be distributed on to the hand only –we will not be giving communion on to the tongue at this time due to the high risk of infection.
